Thanks to everyone involved for their contributions! Our interview series will continue to expand in Fall 2021, with more Speakers relating their knowledge about plastic. We need this in order to prove and/or improve health, safety, and environment protocols for working independently with plastic.

**REAC** has also joined a research project in partnership with the University of Alberta Department of Mechanical Engineering to test emissions control and personal protective equipment devices. Precious Plastics began providing open source videos for independent plastics recycling in 2012 in Europe. There are currently tens of thousands of independent plastics recyclers around the world utilizing these and other templates to produce useful items from our post-consumer plastic 'waste'.

As part of our new Natural Gas Strategy, the province of Alberta announced a new Circular Plastics Economy in Fall 2020, giving further mandate to this important work. Our first financial contribution towards a Plastic Radio Ad Competition is confirmed from Dow Canada. We are also reaching out to Nova Chemicals, InterPipeline, and other virgin plastics manufacturers.
